CHOSEN UPDATE!

Several months ago we announced that "Chosen," an Erie based, community-oriented organization that provides "Durable Home Healthcare Items" to those in need, desired to partner with First Methodist Church.

This organization receives gently used equipment and new supply items such as wheelchairs, walkers, transfer benches, shower chairs, bed canes, and unexpired diabetic supplies and makes them available to the public at NO COST. Hundreds of items are distributed each month from their Erie ministry location.

It was recently noted that a significant number of individuals making use of this ministry were coming from the Warren area. We have committed to be a drop off site for items that can then be sent to Erie for servicing and then be distributed again at a later date. More importantly, we will now be a pick up site where individuals from the Warren area can come to receive assistance!

In our ongoing efforts to fulfill the directives of Matthew 25 (caring for the sick), First Methodist Church has committed to partner with Chosen in this ministry in order to better assist and benefit our community.

Our first official day of operation will be Wednesday April 10th!

As we will be using our church garage as a pick up and drop off site, we are in need of two volunteers each day to help distribute medical items from our church garage.
