### Registration & Tuition

Tuition for the program is as follows:

\$100 for the first child  
\$75 for the second child  
\$50 for the third child  
\$25 for each additional child  
in the family.

Confidential Scholarships are available, upon request through the director (Heidi Ketzko).

We do require parents needing a scholarship to contribute \$25 by the end of the program year. This request must come from the parent (s).

This tuition covers meals, study, and recreation materials. Payments may be made in installments throughout the program year. If other Arrangements are necessary, please contact Heidi Ketzko at 814-723-4930 Extension 3.

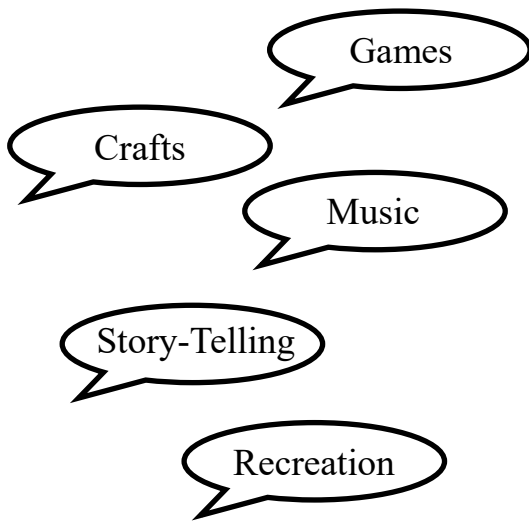

The LOGOS after school program at First Methodist Church strives to provide a place where students in grades K-6 find faith, fellowship and fun - and of course, good food. We believe the best way to help students grow is to provide a **Fun** and **Safe** Environment where kids can experience Authentic Relationships and Christ-Centered Teaching.

## Fun and Safe Environment

What fun things do our kids experience each week at LOGOS?



We believe the best fun is had when everyone feels safe. All of our teachers and leaders are required to have clearances and background checks. The safety of your child is our number one priority.

## Christ-Centered Teaching

Kids who attend LOGOS learn about Christ through specific learning and modeled behavior. Everything from snack and games to music and Bible lessons is designed to help kids experience who Jesus is and how He teaches us to live.

Our Bible lessons include stories like:

- Creation
- Noah and the flood
- Jesus’ parables (stories with a moral)

In faith building, kids learn tools for faith such as:

- How to talk to God
- How to worship God everyday
- Why singing is important, even when we don’t like to or think we can’t sing

## Authentic Relationships

God wants to be in a relationship with each of us... but how do we do that when we can’t see him?

How do kids learn what safe relationships look like when this world is full of so many broken relationships?

At LOGOS, we believe modeling safe, healthy and authentic relationships is one of the most important lessons a child can learn.

Through games and other activities, kids learn how to have positive relationships with one another.

At our weekly meals, a consistent “table parent” demonstrates God’s love by caring for the kids at their table. Since your child’s table parent is the same each week, they can follow up on good and bad things in life and demonstrate consistent care.
